

SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION: Imagine Learning

Purpose: To utilize Imagine Learning as a teaching and learning platform which allows digital access to the Illustrative Mathematics curriculum in grades K-8. Furthermore, using the Illustrative Mathematics curriculum as a Tier 1 elementary math curriculum for grades K-8.

Amount of Contract: \$92,715.00

Description/Scope of Services:

Imagine Learning is the online platform for teaching our Tier 1 math curriculum, Illustrative Mathematics. The platform provides educators with all the resources they need to plan and teach lessons. This includes unit overview videos, planning maps with materials needed, real-world videos to introduce the concepts of each unit to students, and overview videos for educators with the key learning goals and strategies highlighted in each unit. The platform allows easy access to daily lesson slides with teaching notes, virtual manipulatives, online games that can be assigned to students, and access for students to complete and submit work online. The platform also has family-facing resources such as letters and videos for caregivers for each unit.
