ICE -

no longer stays out of hospitals, churches, schools

David Murphy (interim superintendent) sent out an email about this.

We do not allow anyone who is not Cambridge Police into our buildings.

Teachers are not authorized to share any info about students.

We would not open the door to ICE.

We can support students if they get home and parents are not there - backup plans.

The purpose of this policy change is intended to create fear.

The city is hosting "Know Your Rights" workshops.

Are we having formal discussions or circles with kids?

We are trying to pace ourselves with the info we share. We will need to talk with all kids about having a backup plan.

How do we support kids to get papers and apply for college and jobs?

Obi will talk with the high school about this.
